(The) revelation of Jesus Christ  
to uncover, disclose, reveal revelation given by of from  
Jesus Christ (subjective genitive)  
-this isn't a revelation "about" Jesus, which would shift  
the meaning to an objective genitive (the gospels are "about" Jesus)

KJV things which must shortly come to pass

(things which will or have to happen) ἃ <sup>in, with speed</sup> δεῖ γενεσθαι <sup>speed</sup> ἐν τάχει

When these things happen, they will happen quickly - with speed

KJV 1:2 Who bare record of the word of God, and of the testimony of Jesus Christ, and of all the things that he saw.

A) μακάριος "blessed" same word as Mt 5:3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11 etc  
 Also here Rev 1:3 and 14:13, 16:15, 19:9, 20:6, 22:7, 14

this uncovering, revealing → apocalypse so 'faithers' would have  
 a blessing, knowing the redemptive plan of God from the  
 heavenlies

B) 'reading', 'hearing', 'keeping' three participles, present active

C) καιρός → not 'chronos' → two greek words for time  
 chronos, (our English word chronology etc) vs καιρός - season,  
 set time
