We need to let the peace that God imparts to us rule in our hearts. The peace of God has the power to eradicate our fear. Trust in God and stand strong. **Colossians 3:14**

*KJV*

“And above all these things put on charity [*agape: love*], which is the bond of perfectness.”

*NCV*

“Love is what holds you all together in perfect unity.”

*CEV*

“Love is more important than anything else. It is what ties everything completely together.”

*NIV*

“And over all these virtues put on love, which binds them all together in perfect unity.”

*NLT*

“Above all, clothe yourselves in love, which binds us all together in perfect harmony.”

*Message*

“And regardless of what else you put on, wear love. It’s your basic, all-purpose garment. Never be without it.”
