## Elements / στοιχεῖον

Galatians 4:3 "Even so we, when we were children, were in bondage under elements of the world." (στοιχεῖα) noun-acc-neut-pl
Galatians 4:9 "But now, after that ye have known God or rather are known of God, how turn ye again to the weak and beggarly elements whereunto ye desire again to be in bondage?" (στοιχεῖα)  noun-acc-neut-pl
Galatians 5:25
"If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit." (στοιχῶμεν)  verb-sub-pres-act-1p-pl
Galatians 6:16 "And as many as walk according to this rule, peace be on them, and mercy, and upon the Israel of God." (στοιχήσουσιν verb-ind-fut-act
Colossians 2:8 "Beware lest any man spoil you through philosophy and vain deceit, after the tradition of men, after the rudiments of the world, and not after Christ." (στοιχεῖα) noun-acc-neut-pl
Colossians 2:20 "Wherefore if ye be dead with Christ from the rudiments of the world why as though living in the world are ye subject to the ordinances" (στοιχειων)   noun-gen-neut-pl
Hebrews 5:12 "For when the time ye ought to be teachers, ye have need that one teach you again which be the first principles of the oracles of God" (στοιχεῖα)   noun-acc-neut-pl
Strong' #4747 στοιχεῖον – stoicheion something orderly in arrangement, serial constituent – (element, principle, rudiment).
Strongs #4748 στοιχέω – stoicheō to range in regular line, to march in (military) rank – (keep step), to conform to virtue and piety: – walk (orderly).

- Stoa in Greek architecture – a covered structure used as a walkway or a meeting place.

- Aristophanes Eccl., 652: 'length of a shadow' by which time is calculated

- Plato linguistically refers to a sound that is in a series of others.

Outside of New Testament Usage of στοιχεῖον

- Empedocles – Doctrine of Four Elements
